The committee believes that God is calling us specifically to a man who will:

1. First and foremost will preach the Word of God with passion for the living Christ, thus bringing glory to our gracious, merciful and glorious Lord God—one who will preach with fervency and urgency declaring to the people of the congregation their transgressions and encourage them to repentance. We desire a preacher who will preach boldly to the conscience and to the heart as well as the mind.
2. Will continue to support the gospel around the world through our world missions program—not just financially, but through prayer and encouragement of our missionaries in the field.
3. Will recognize that the church in America is weak and anemic and needs fortifying, not only through the strong preaching of the Word, but also through discipling, evangelizing the lost and nurturing the flock.
4. Is open to change and will challenge the status quo. This does not mean change for the sake of change. We desire a man who will examine the church, the culture and the world around us and consider how we as a body of believers can impact our culture for Christ while not allowing the culture to negatively impact the church.
5. Has a heart for the lost and will encourage the body of Christ here at Grace to evangelize the lost.
6. Will continue to equip and encourage our youth in Christ.
7. Understands the biblical family and will encourage its growth.
8. Is a man of character and integrity, who is humble before God and his fellow man.
9. Is able to lead the church, its officers, and its ministry to impact Fort Payne and the surrounding area for Christ.
