



## **Youth Ministries Assistant Director**

### *Job Description*

#### **Purpose:**

To reach out to, disciple, and equip the Jr. and Sr. High Students of WRPC and in our community into deeper relationships with Jesus Christ their Lord and Savior and to empower them to become life-long warriors for the Kingdom of God throughout the world.

#### **Requirements:**

The Youth Ministries Assistant Director must be a male with maturity in Christ, love for students, biblical insight and discernment, and administrative and organizational skills. He also must have a college degree and 3+ years of ministry experience. This person is to aid in the fulfillment of the purpose, vision, and philosophy of the Youth Ministry and church as a whole.

#### **Responsibilities:**

- Build relationships with Jr. and Sr. High Students to assist them in their relationships with Jesus Christ.
- Build relationships with and assist the church at large in the discipleship of parents of Jr. and Sr. High Students to minister alongside them in sharing the gospel with their children.
- Lead, organize, and develop the weekly Jr. High programs. This includes Crossroads (Jr. High Wednesday night large group), and Sunday School.
- Assist in leading, as needed, in the weekly Sr. High programs. This includes The Well (Sr. High Wednesday night large group), and Sunday School.
- Assist in leading, organizing, and developing weekly discipleship groups for the Jr. and Sr. High Ministries.
- Assist in leading, organizing, and developing the Student Servant Team.
- Lead and organize events, retreats, summer camps and mission trips for the Jr. High Ministries.
- Assist in leading and organizing events, retreats, summer camps and mission trips for the Sr. High Ministries.
- Assist in recruiting, nurturing, and equipping a team of adult volunteers to serve in all areas of the Youth Ministry.
- Spend time studying in the area of Youth Ministries to sharpen skills.
- Work as a team to lead the Youth Ministry alongside the Youth Ministries Director, Administrative Assistant, and Intern(s) in any and all duties that may arise.
- The Assistant Youth Ministries Director will split their time with approximately 70% going to Jr. High and 30% going to Sr. High.



**Accountability:**

- The Youth Ministries Assistant Director will be held accountable by the Youth Ministries Director.
- Performance evaluations will be made quarterly for the first year and annually thereafter.
