The Chapin Presbyterian Church (CPC) and Youth Ministry

Chapin Presbyterian Church has a youth ministry of approximately 90 young people. The youth ministry maintains a weekly Sunday morning, Sunday evening, and outreach ministry schedule. Chapin Presbyterian Church is a member of the Presbyterian Church in America. The congregation was founded in 2002 and today has 570 members. The church constructed its current facilities in 2006 and is involved in an expansion project, which is scheduled to be completed in spring of 2011. Chapin Presbyterian Church has a traditional worship style in its main services. The church is led by a senior pastor, assistant pastor, and staff of six full and part time individuals, of which the youth pastor is one.

The CPC youth ministry mission

The CPC youth group is a fellowship where every young person is taught and encouraged to have a personal, growing relationship with Jesus Christ in an enthusiastic environment controlled by the word of God. The CPC youth group is a place where every young person has fun, develops healthy relationships with God, family, and friends, and learns to apply the lordship of Christ through the teaching of the word of God in every area of daily living. The CPC youth group promotes a ministry-mindset in its young people by living out the love of Christ through good works, service to others, and evangelism in our community, nation, and world. The CPC youth group is a place where every young person can call home where the youth pastor, youth leaders, and the young people themselves strive to make every young person feel wanted, welcomed, and included as part of the group.

Organization structure of the youth ministry

The CPC youth pastor is supervised by the church senior staff. The CPC youth pastor also ministers in cooperation with a Youth Leadership Team (YLT), a group of 5 to 7 youth ministry leaders that meets monthly. The CPC youth pastor also leads and encourages a Youth Ministry Team (YMT) comprised of all youth ministry volunteers.

Financial compensation
