3. Insure that all the technical elements of the service are in place and ready to go for Sunday morning worship
4. The worship director will embrace his/her role to disciple and mentor those involved in worship and arts as a primary thrust of their time here.
5. He/she will eagerly enjoy and accept other opportunities to lead worship during the week for special events and for our youth ministry on a regular basis.
6. We are praying that our worship director will enjoy the gospel of grace and grow more deeply connected to Jesus because of his/her time here.

**How do we define worship at GracePointe?**

Christian worship is offering glory, honor, and submission to the triune God by his people who understand their sinfulness but who respond to God's character and mighty acts as revealed in scripture by faith, in the name of Jesus Christ, and through the power of the Holy Spirit.
