RESPONSIBLE TO

Direct supervision from the Senior Pastor with weekly meetings with staff; oversight from the Session.

PRINCIPAL FUNCTION

To establish a vibrant and creative music program, that is largely traditional but incorporates contemporary styles, inspiring worship for the glory of God.

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Oversee all musical aspects of the weekly Sunday worship service to include:
 - a. Selecting psalms, contemporary praise songs, and hymns befitting the sermon theme/text.
 - b. Coordinating and directing the rehearsal and performance of this music (i.e. managing volunteer orchestra and choir).
 - c. Arrange, transcribe, and transpose music for orchestra.
 - d. Directing the congregation in singing through either piano or vocals.
2. Lead children's music program.
3. Direct special music programs and seasonal services.
4. Oversee the maintenance and usage of the church pianos, scheduling repair and tuning as needed.
5. Annually assess the music budget to accomplish specified responsibilities.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Strong profession of Christian faith; committed to Reformed tradition, with a desire to serve the Lord with passion and leadership in a music ministry.
2. Undergraduate degree in music with a high degree of proficiency in an instrument sufficient to lead a music team (i.e. piano, guitar, voice, etc.).
3. Education in choral leadership, or equivalent experience.
4. Able to use music notation software.
5. Experience in leading the congregation in worship.
6. Able to mentor musicians.
7. Good listener, self-motivated, strong relational skills, humble but passionate.
8. Willing to be an active member of our church.
