Visionary: Clearly communicate the mission of FPC and the Women's Ministry, and effectively motivate others toward our shared vision.

Manager: Effectively utilize ministry resources to locate, train and encourage the Women's Council, as they manage responsibility for ministry activity. Seek to lead the Council in shaping overall vision and direction of ministry.

Liaison: Collaborate and partner with pastors, staff and the community in an ongoing working relationship.

Responsibilities

Interface with the Women's Council by recruiting, equipping and training these leaders, and lead the Council's monthly meetings.

Develop outreach opportunities and build relationships with new members to discover areas of service.

Oversee annual budget.

Assist pastors and staff with pastoral ministry/ counseling situations. Attend discipleship and staff meetings. Reports to pastor over Women's Ministry.

Serve as a point person for Women's Ministry before the church and also during functions outside the church. Represent the vision of the Session to the women in the church and communicate to the Session and pastoral staff the needs and concerns of our women.

Women's Events:

Bible Studies: There are five women's studies officially sponsored by First Presbyterian's Adult Discipleship Ministry. These meet in various places in the community, including the church, at different times throughout the week.

Women's Gatherings: About three times a year the women's ministry sponsors a women's event that allows for fun, fellowship, and biblical teaching.

TGC Women's Event: First Presbyterian Church hosted The Gospel Coalition's Word Filled Women's conference designed to support the growth of Word-based ministry among women in and through the local church.

TEA, Teaching Encouragement and Agape: This time is meant for fellowship, hearing from women from all walks of life and held quarterly in a member's home.

REFIT: Refit is a fitness community. Its vision is to create a fitness experience that changes people from the inside out, and this vision is accomplished by focusing on the heart as a muscle and a soul. This fitness class meets once a week on the First Pres campus, and is led and facilitated by members.
