 - Leader Meetings
 - Check - In
- Coordinate activities and details with Rush Event Contractor

Other Duties

- Attend & contribute to Watershed staff meetings, student prayer and student Servant Teams
- Attend yearly student ministry staff retreat
- Attend Perimeter staff prayer and staff lunch
- Meet 1/1 with Watershed Director 2/month
- Take a "God Day" 1/month for renewal, rest and connection with God
- Attend Breakfast club as needed
