Specifically, the candidate will cover the following responsibilities:

1. Worship Leadership

- Plan weekly worship services in conjunction with the Senior Pastor and worship team leaders
- All Sunday morning worship prepared to ensure the highest level of grace driven excellence
- Responsible for all elements of the volunteer led worship (including the worship teams, sound team and special elements – choir, solo, special music etc.)
- **STRONGLY PREFERRED:** Proficiency in vocal music leadership with an instrument such as the guitar or keyboard.

And at least one of the following two areas:

2. Children and Youth

- Identify and disciple a volunteer staff and then oversee effective discipleship programs for the youth.

3. Preaching and Administrative

- Attend regular staff meetings
- Attend Session meetings
- Preach up to 8x a year

The successful candidate must:

- Already possess or be desirous of pursuing a pastoral degree.
- Be in agreement with Reformed theology as stated in the Westminster standards.

Established in 1952, Berea consists of a congregation of about 150 souls spanning multiple generations. It is located in Hockessin, Delaware near the Pennsylvania, Maryland, and New Jersey state lines. The immediate surroundings feature a developed suburban community that is increasingly diverse.
