Children's Ministry Coordinator Job Description

This position is a part-time* leadership role, approximately 25 hours a week, focused on assisting in the spiritual formation of the children (ages birth—6th grade) of FWPC.

Mission Statement: Nurturing a joy for loving God and loving people by proclaiming and living out the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Fort Worth Presbyterian church is a diverse body of 425 members that has been served by two senior pastors in it's 25 years with 6 full-time staff. We believe that God's grace changes hearts leading to loving our neighbors. We have a blended worship service focused on congregational participation, observing weekly communion. We have several outward facing ministries and our congregational life is socially vibrant and interconnected beyond Sunday mornings.

Areas of Responsibility

- All Children's Ministry programs (birth-6th Grade) during: Worship, Sunday School, Small Groups, Ladies Bible Study, VBS, special events and assisting in Super Wednesday's,
- Recruiting, screening, scheduling and training all volunteers serving in Children's Ministries
- Selecting and evaluating curriculum for use in Children's Ministry
- Oversight of the Nursery Coordinator and the Children's Ministry Budget
- Enforcing all policies

This is accomplished by furthering children's ministry programs to reach all children. This involves coming alongside parents in the formation of their growing families, nurturing a deep faith among children and equipping staff and lay leaders for dynamic and engaging children's ministry.
