

Education & Family Ministries Pastor

The E & FM position has been established in order to provide an effectively coordinated education and family ministry with a special emphasis on Youth at CPC. The position will require both hands on involvement in a variety of ministries and the capability to initiate, organize, promote, and staff programs with volunteers from the congregation. This is a salaried position. The individual holding this position is accountable to the Session, the Education Committee and is under the direct supervision of the Senior Pastor. (An ordained TE will be extended the call as an Associate Pastor, an un-ordained man will be called as an Assistant Pastor or (Director) with the intention of serving on the full Session after one year of service.) There is an emphasis on administration, organizational skills as well as teaching/preaching abilities.

Requirements

- License/Ordainable in the PCA
- Adherence to the Reformed Standards
- Commitment to Morning and Evening Lord's Day Worship Services

Preferences

- Married
- Between the ages of 25-45
- Willing to Commit to 5 years barring a clear call to another ministry

Compensation: Total package 65-75,000 (includes Health benefits)
