

**Smyrna Presbyterian Church (PCA), Smyrna, GA seeks an organist.**

The successful candidate must demonstrate superior organ skills. The organ is a three-manual Rodgers (2005). The organist is responsible for the following services: Sunday Morning, Sunday Evening, Wednesday Night Choir Practice, Holy Week Services and Christmas Eve Services. Also, included is accompaniment of the Chancel Choir (about 25 volunteers (SATB) and all instrumental music for the church (i.e. Prelude, Offertory and Postlude) as well as rehearsals with other church musicians and soloists.

The organist may, on rare occasion, be required to accompany the choir for a Major Work or Choral Concert.

The organist reports to the Choirmaster and the Session and is expected to plan music for all services and for communicating this in a timely manner for church bulletin preparations.

Additional responsibilities include playing for weddings and funerals (fees separate from salary) and securing a reliable substitute as needed.

This is a part-time position (18 hrs. per week). No Health Care or Pension is offered. Salary is negotiable, anticipated between \$20,000 – \$24,000 per year depending on education and experience. Candidates will be required to travel to Smyrna, GA for an interview and audition.
