Job Title: Senior Pastor, Cheyenne Mountain PCA (CMPCA)

Status: Full Time

Accountability: The Senior Pastor is accountable to the Session and the Presbytery.

Description: The Senior Pastor is responsible for providing pastoral leadership and administrative oversight of the church's ministries, including preaching, teaching, stewardship, and fellowship. He will work with the Session and church staff to nurture a healthy congregational life.

Responsibilities:

- Provide Biblical preaching 3 to 4 times per month
- Lead congregational worship in conjunction with the Ruling Elders and Assistant Pastor
- To moderate Session meetings and staff meetings monthly or as the need arises, submitting to the ordained leaders, while also providing leadership to Elders, Deacons and lay leaders
- To provide pastoral services for those in crises situations, visiting church members and counseling as needed
- To administer sacraments of communion monthly and baptism, as required
- To officiate at weddings and funerals of members
- To assist in teaching new members classes as needed
- To attend and support church functions

Qualifications:

Credentials and Theology

- Graduate of a nationally recognized seminary or divinity school
- Ordained Teaching Elder, in good standing, in the PCA

- Understands well the Gospel and means of grace

Experience

- 5+ years of experience in full-time pastoral ministry
- Experience as a Senior Pastor, including church administration and supervision

Skills and Abilities

- A gifted, sound exegetical, reformed **teacher and preacher**; able to engage contemporary theological trends and issues
- A **shepherd/pastor** who is approachable, encouraging and caring towards the flock
- A **team member** who is responsive to collaborative/shared leadership
- A **servant leader** who can lead staff, the congregation and key lay leaders; characterized by openness, honesty, and transparency, with a sense of humility; able to inspire people to take action
