POSITION OVERVIEW

ESSENTIAL JOB FUNCTION:

Discipleship Track

- 1.) Implement a three year scope and sequence for the 6-12 grade for Bible Apps, Gangway and Core Discipleship program
- 2.) Oversee and the Gangway program, staff and volunteers
- 3.) Oversee and the Bible App program, staff and volunteers
- 4.) Oversee a Mission program, staff, and volunteers
- 5.) Oversee Sunday School program, staff and volunteers
- 6.) Oversee Communicants Class.
- 7.) Oversee Evangelism Program.

- Community Transformation & Missions

- 1.) Oversee Campus Clubs
- 2.) Support Chapel Program at WA for HS and MS
- 3.) Participate in seasonal mission efforts to the Avondale Community
- 4.) Oversee multiple summer missions trips for 6-12th graders

Faith and Work

- 1.) Work with Faith and Work Teams to establish an event for students to participate
- 2.) Have a short series (2-3 week) about Faith and Work

College Connection

- 1.) Winter social event
- 2.) Summer Bible study
- 3.) Quarterly connections including phone calls, care packages, etc.

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1.) Mentor/Train Department Staff and Volunteers
- 2.) Develop a Volunteer Base (teachers, worship team, drama team, greeters, etc.)
- 3.) Develop a First Impressions Team for Students and Young Families
- 4.) Oversee the safety and security of the entire Student area
- 5.) Serve as a liaison between CRPC and Westminster Academy (teachers, parents, administration)
- 6.) Develop and maintain the annual budget for Student Ministries and identify future budget needs
- 7.) Promote communication and understanding between parents and the ministry
- 8.) Partner with families and equip them to raise their Student in the fear and admonition of the Lord

- 2. An understanding and commitment to the philosophy of ministry of the CRPC leadership
- 3. Must affirm the Westminster Confession of Faith and the main tenets of reformed theology

- 5. Must affirm the vision and core values of CRPC
- 6. Evidence of student leadership development skills
- 7. A love and passion for students and their families.

- 10. Experience in student ministry
- 11. Bachelor of Arts
