To oversee, direct, and set vision for the Senior High Youth Ministry, including Senior High staff, volunteers, students, and families with the ultimate goal of leading students in becoming disciples of Jesus Christ, following him in every area of their lives.

DESCRIPTION OF PRIMARY RESPONSIBILITIES (WITH PERCENTAGE OF TIME SPENT):

- Contact Work (Relational Ministry) (40%)
 - Foster spiritual growth among the Mitchell Road covenant students as well as those from the community who participate in our ministries
 - Lead a Journey Group
 - Disciple students through one on one and smaller group meetings
 - Partner with parents to encourage the spiritual growth of their students
- Plan, implement, lead SH program responsibilities (25%)
 - Teach SH Night and Sunday School
 - Plan and implement mission trips & retreats
- Recruit and develop adult and student leaders to serve in the SH ministry (15%)
- Collaborate with the Jr High Director about overall youth programs, as well as leading the staff/staff meetings (10%)
- Collaboratively and creatively, bring vision and direction to youth ministry (5%)
- Collaboration with Asst. SH Director for Journey Group planning and implementation (5%)
