



Job Description – Youth Pastor

The following full-time position is presently available and will include a pay package of \$48-58K, depending on qualification and experience. Christ Church Greensboro – a church planted in downtown Greensboro, NC, seven years ago – is a church of the Presbyterian Church in America (PCA). It has grown in the last seven years and averages about 350 people in attendance. The church gathers in a non-traditional facility, is engaged in outreach and mercy ministry, and enjoys a mix of college students, families, singles, grad students and seasoned saints. The youth ministry currently has 30 students attending (grades 6-12) and there is a large population of young children coming up. Major Responsibilities

1. Develops a team to lead and oversee all the ministries to the middle school and high school students in our church, including Sunday School, Youth Group, Small Groups, and events.
2. Partners with parents to encourage the spiritual growth of their students.
3. Personally spends regular time with youth in relationship-building, discipleship & outreach.
4. Recruits, trains and oversees the adult volunteer leaders required to carry out the youth ministry.
5. Recommends and implements all teaching curriculum and related materials for youth.
6. Maintains regular and consistent communication with parents, youth and congregation.
7. Champions the ministry to youth before the session, staff, and the congregation.
8. Administrates all youth ministry including: scheduling, communication & budget.
9. Assists in morning worship services as needed.
10. Serves as part of the staff team.
11. Reports to the associate pastor.
