



## The Opportunity: Assistant Pastor for Worship and Service

Lexington Presbyterian Church (LPC) is located in the midlands of South Carolina. Historically a small agricultural town that also served as a bedroom community to the state's capitol, Lexington has experienced tremendous growth over the last 40 years. Lexington is a thriving, diverse, family-oriented community with strong schools and a growing economy.

LPC's Vision is "making disciples as we worship, love and serve." In light of this, we are excited to announce a new staff position for our church.

The Assistant Pastor for Worship and Service (APWS) will play a critical role in shepherding two of the three areas of our Discipleship model: Worship and Serve. Therefore, we are seeking an ordained - or nearly ordained - Teaching Elder in the PCA. In light of his pastoral calling, the APWS will possess a heart for shepherding our musicians and congregation. Our hope is that worship and service will be the practical outflow of his pastoral ministry. The APWS will have musical gifts and a commitment to disciple-making in our church and community by serving one-another and our neighbors.

The APWS will spend about 70% (25-30 hours) of his week focusing on the worship ministry of LPC, and about 30% (15-20 hours) of his week helping cultivate a culture of service for our congregation and community.

- **Worship:** Along with the Senior Pastor, the APWS will help plan, coordinate and lead our liturgy and musical elements of our Sunday Morning Worship Services. He will be asked to preach 1-4 times per year and assist with communion, weddings and funerals as needed.
- **Serve:** The APWS will shepherd, mobilize and encourage our members, groups, guests, deacons, elders and staff to serve the kingdom in our church and community.
