This position will be responsible to the Session, the Senior Pastor, and the Youth Leadership Committee.

Qualifications

- Has a seminary degree or specialized training in Christian education ministry, and/or two plus years' experience in youth ministry
- Is currently called to youth ministry
- Is a gifted teacher
- Is supportive and knowledgeable of the Reformed faith as related to the Westminster Confession of Faith
- Is a self-starter, demonstrating initiative, and is organized and task-oriented in planning and execution of youth activities
- Is able to communicate effectively with all ages, with special skill in relating to middle & high school aged students
- Is able to work with staff and volunteers wisely, cordially, and effectively

Duties

- Lead, plan, coordinate and evaluate overall Youth Ministry program for NCPC students in 6th through 12th grades
- Develop and plan weekly programs, including weekly large group meetings for senior high and middle school youth groups
- Teach Youth Sunday School and weekly programs, as well as other times as requested
- Develop a youth leadership team
- Organize and lead discipleship ministries for the youth, including personal discipleship of students and young people
- Develop long-range plan and year-round activity calendar
- Communicate with the congregation about Youth Ministry objectives and activities
- Participate in the preparation and execution of the annual youth budget
- Supervise, promote, and recruit volunteers for seasonal programs and events (e.g. VBS, missions involvement, etc.)
- Reach out to and connect with all NCPC high- and middle-school students as well as their friends and other visiting students
- Recruit, supervise, and train volunteers for the Youth Ministry
- Meet with the Senior Pastor on a regular basis and report regularly to Session on Youth Ministry objectives and activities

Compensation

This is a full-time position. Compensation of salary and benefits (health insurance, retirement contributions, social security contribution, etc.) will be determined based on qualifications and experience.
