

That **Overture 3** from South Florida Presbytery (“Amend *BCO* 32-19 to Allow Counsel by Any Communing Member in All Levels of Courts,” p. 39) be answered in the affirmative as amended. **100-4-0**

Therefore, the South Florida Presbytery overtures the 46th PCA General Assembly to amend *BCO* 32-19 as follows to allow representation in all of its courts by any communing member of the Presbyterian Church in America. (Deletions indicated by ~~strike-through~~; additions by underlining)

32-19. No professional counsel shall be permitted as such to appear and plead in cases of process in any court; but an accused person may, if he desires it, be represented before the Session ~~any church court~~ by any communing member of any church in that presbytery ~~the same particular church~~, or before any other court, by any member of the Presbyterian Church in America ~~that court~~. A member of the court so employed shall not be allowed to sit in judgment in the case.
