

Job Description for Music Director

Position Description:

A successful Music Director at Restoration (PCA) would envision his/her role as a ministry of supporting and developing the public worship of our church. The Music Director is responsible for planning, coordinating, and executing the music for the weekly service in a way that is consistent with the vision, values, and mission of Restoration, in conjunction with the Pastor.

Desired experience:

Previous experience in worship planning and directing a worship team and/or band; exposure to diverse forms and styles of music; some experience with technical aspects of a worship service.

Position Qualifications:

- Find identity, meaning and purpose in the person and work (life, death, and resurrection) of Jesus
- Willingness to participate in the life of Restoration PCA as a covenant member, fully participating in a life consistent with our identity and mission
- Dedicated to Restoration's vision and excited to serve in the context of church revitalization
- Strong relational skills, able to work well with people
- Dependable, responsible, self-motivated, and creative
- Passionate about seeing the gospel expressed through music in worship
- Competent musician with ability to arrange and lead eclectic styles of music
- Committed to liturgical worship and willing to work with pastor to structure weekly worship around the sermon theme
- Willing to work with varying levels of talent, fostering an atmosphere of *gracious* excellence

Position Responsibilities (Approx. 5 hours per week):

1. Sunday duties (2.5 hours)

- Conduct a pre-service Sunday morning rehearsal
- Lead music in the worship service

2. In-between Sunday duties (2-3 hours)

- Select songs for the worship service, working in conjunction with the Pastor
- Communicate with music team members about details for the service (no later than Wednesday)
- Work with the church administrator for insertion of songs in Order of Worship/Bulletin
- Recruit and assimilate new, capable musicians into the music team
- Plan and conduct a rehearsal time either weekly or monthly
- Attend a monthly planning meeting with the Pastor

Reports to: Pastor

Responsibilities may be subject to some change as deemed necessary by the Pastor
