

Covenant Presbyterian Church is located in Denver's western suburb of Wheat Ridge, Colorado. The church has existed since the 1950s and has current members that have been attending for widely varying periods of time. The church building is fully owned by the church without debt. As a Gospel-centric body of believers, we hold to the inerrancy of the Scriptures and enthusiastically embrace the Biblical truths of historically reformed theology.

We desire a solo pastor who recognizes the primacy of preaching and teaching among his pastoral duties. We seek a pastor who is deeply committed to the reformed truths contained in the Bible and the Westminster Confession of Faith, and who will faithfully proclaim and apply these truths to the congregation. We seek a pastor who will develop the spiritual lives of the members of the congregation through teaching and preaching of the Word. He will work with our part time administrative assistants, elders, and other church leaders to consistently develop opportunities in the congregation for personal spiritual growth, church fellowship, discipleship, leadership development, and Christian service.

1. **Ministry experience:** M.Div. minimum, plus at least 2 years pastoral experience preferred.

2. **Christ-centered heart and ministry:** Must have a proven personal track record of living out the fruit of union with Jesus Christ. This consists of:

- a. A demonstrable, long-standing and well-attested personal walk with Christ.
- b. A record of repentance and softness of heart with an eagerness to deal forthrightly and in a gospel-centered way with his own sin and the sins of others.
- c. A Christ-centered public and private ministry.
- d. A thoroughly covenantal approach to life with strong convictions around personal piety.
- e. A humility that presses forward Christ's Kingdom without making the ministry "about himself."

3. **Gifts:**

- a. Leadership. Must have a clear vision for the direction of the church and a proven track record of leading others and managing a growing organization. Sees the importance of good order, and understands well the role of elders and deacons in the government and discipline of the church.
- b. Teaching. Must have proven track record of public and private Word-based ministry that results in changed lives. Able to connect the Bible's riches to life's realities.
- c. Evangelism. Must have proven track record of leading people to Christ as a way of life. Must be a "people-gatherer," able to move into a new environment and rise to the top as an influencer and leader of men.
- d. Hospitality. Must have proven track record of opening his home to people in ministry. His family's "kitchen table" must be a place of warmth and wisdom.

We are a church that has recently experienced the resignation of our beloved pastor. We have a worship service at 11:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Sundays with Sunday School at 9:45 a.m. with classes for all ages. We have a traditional worship format. In missions, we are involved with supporting several missionaries and offer prayer support and other assistance to various ministries and missionaries. We aspire to be a body of believers that increasingly finds opportunities to reach out to the community in evangelism and service and desire our pastor to lead us in this work.

We prayerfully seek God's guidance in this search process and we are already praying for this pastor, his family, and the members of his current church.
