

Job Description for Assistant Pastor for Outreach Ministries

Job Description: The APOM will be responsible for developing, conducting, and coordinating various ministries of gospel outreach to include, but not limited to, the following:

1. Living in such a way as to be a model and catalyst to stimulate others to desire to engage in personal evangelism.
2. Working with the session in overseeing the church's Missions and Mercy Ministry Team [3-M], recruiting and encouraging team members in the outworking of strategies for Evangelism, Mercy-ministries, and Missions (national and international).
3. Implementing a periodic course of evangelistic training (e. g., Evangelism Explosion or Two Ways to Live).
3. Providing encouragement and accountability for church members to engage evangelistically with their FRANs (Friends, Relatives, Neighbors, Associates) through relationship building, need-meeting, etc.
4. Encouraging members to be regularly praying evangelistically for unconverted FRANs
5. Enlisting members to share testimonies of evangelistic opportunities as an encouragement and stimulus for the rest of the congregation.
6. Developing church-events/activities that would provide the context for evangelistic communication; e. g., "Drive-by Prayer" or Neighborhood Survey or some other need-meeting activity.
7. In connection with the Session and 3-M Team, developing a congregational local and global Missions Ministry, including a regular Missions Conference, communication with the church's missionaries, encouraging/coordinating church members' participation in short-term and long-term, local and global mission opportunities.

Qualifications:

1. Male.
2. Age: mid-twenties to early-forties.
3. A tangible track record evidencing a gift and/or passion for personal/lifestyle evangelism.
4. College degree required and Seminary degree preferred (but not absolutely necessary).
5. Married preferred, but singles will also be considered.

Salary: up to \$45K total compensation package for full-time (but will also consider adjusting expectations/salary for part-time applicants).

Furthermore: Senior Pastor is nearing retirement, so this position could possibly lead to pastoral succession.
