### **Job Description** (information limited to the box size)

This church requires a bi-vocational or semi-retired pastor; one who has an income in addition to his salary from the church. A manse is available. Sunday School for both children and adults is held every Sunday morning, but no evening service. A Wednesday night Bible Study/Prayer meeting is held every week. The Pastor would preach in the Worship Service and share in the teaching of the Adult Sunday School class. In the past the Pastor and two laymen have rotated teaching each quarter. The Pastor usually leads the Wednesday night Bible study which normally is 30-40 minutes; then the group updates the prayer list after which the men and women separate for prayer. Average attendance at Sunday Worship is 25; Adult Sunday School, 14; Children's Class, 4; Wednesday night, 10. The WIC meets once a month with an attendance of 8-10; their Bible study is led by one of the members. A men's discipleship small group was held during the Fall of 2017 and Spring 2018. It is expected to resume in the Spring of 2019. The Pastor led the study with 4 men attending during the Fall and 3 during the Spring.

There is a Church Family Dinner every other month, an Annual Fish Fry and a Christmas Brunch. The church has an active Safety Team that provides security for the church.
