

**Assistant Pastor
First Presbyterian Church
Tuscumbia, AL**

The Assistant Pastor job at First Presbyterian Church, Tuscumbia, Alabama, (PCA/Providence Presbytery) is a general pastoral position with an emphasis on oversight of a growing young adult community. We are looking for an ordained or ordainable man in the PCA. There would be preaching, at first on regular Sunday nights (how many would be flexible) and, of course, covering for the senior pastor when he is away. There would be regular pastoral visitation and committee/ministry oversight. Our church has between 300-350 members, with a Sunday morning attendance of anywhere from 150-280 (!) and evening service attendance at 50-100, depending on the time of year and other factors. We are in a small town (7,000) in a metro area of around 140,000. The population is relatively stable; however, the area is not growing significantly in overall population. The church is 194 years old and is a true "First" Church (we have had over 65 funerals in the last 15 years), but the Lord continues to add to our number and we are blessed to have representatives in every age group especially the very young. We are beset, as many churches are, with typical current trends about church attendance and commitment, but we can say with some confidence that God is at work among us and has been for many years. There are no current controversies or factions among us. We are a relatively conservative PCA congregation with historic worship (Trinity Hymnals, etc.) twice on Sunday and a prayer meeting and children's programs on Wednesday night. We have a 3-bedroom 2 bath manse/house for the use of the assistant that is on the edge of the church property, but we might be flexible on that versus a housing allowance down the line.
