This is a paid internship at **\$3800** for a 12 week commitment.

Being on Summer Staff is a 12 week, full time commitment. Please note that an additional job during your internship will not be possible. Hiring decisions are based upon a completed application (including two references). We reserve the right to terminate your position at any time for any unbiblical conduct, safety concerns, and/or leadership detrimental to the body of Christ.

Weekly student ministry staff meetings
Weekly one-on-one with summer staff mentor
Weekly one-one-one with Pastor of Students and Families (training, mentoring & prayer)

Administrative Responsibilities: (20+ hours)

An all around servant's heart is top priority for any individual desiring to minister the good news of the gospel and is a high expectation of the Summer Staff. Weekly responsibilities will be assigned by Tuesday to be finished by the following Tuesday unless otherwise stated.
