Job Description

**Purpose Statement:**

The Director/Pastor of Student Ministries will coordinate the ministry of the church to and through our 6<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> grade students as all honor God, love students and serve the church and world.

**Responsibilities:**

1. Relationships
  - a. Develop healthy relationships with Trinity students by investing time in the schools, at events and at the church to promote their growth in grace.
  - b. Promote loving, fun, and challenging community for growth in grace.
  - c. Lead in pursuing students outside of Trinity.
  - d. Maintain relationships with parents, volunteers, interns and staff.
2. Administration
  - a. Oversee and prepare for weekly meetings, small groups, events and mission trips.
  - b. Ensure student database is up to date and prepare yearly calendar with the help of administrative assistant.
3. Coordination
  - a. Recruit, equip, support and oversee volunteers and interns in their training and ministry.
  - b. Maintain awareness of particular students' needs.
  - c. Work with staff to implement philosophy of ministry.
4. Teaching
  - a. Participate as part of the teaching team for Sunday School and Youth Group.
  - b. Lead a discipleship group for guys as needed

1. A growing prayerful love for God and comfort in your own skin because of the gospel.
2. Character worthy of imitation.
3. A genuine love for students.
4. A strong desire to reach students outside the church.
5. Ability to teach the Bible clearly and winsomely.
6. Gifts suitable to the above responsibilities.
7. Commitment to the Reformed Faith as summarized in the Westminster Confession of Faith.
8. Quality experience in ministry to students.
9. Successful criminal background check (performed by TPC upon submission of release statement).
