



Anchor Student Ministries Summer Internship 2019

Responsibilities:

Planning:

- Meet weekly to help plan and pray for upcoming activities, and will be expected to help the youth pastor to execute activities, events, and retreats.
- Spearhead at least one large group activity per week.
 - Interns will receive help from the youth pastor as they plan, and debrief afterward.

Teaching:

- Teach Sunday School classes as needed.
- Teach two small groups per week
- Interns will receive help in their lesson preparation. They will also have a time to debrief with the youth pastor to discuss how it went, what they did well, and areas to improve.

Discipleship:

- Interns will be given a “focus group” of about 5 students to contact weekly.
- Contact includes 1-on-1 time, group time, phone calls, emails, hand written notes, etc.
- Interns will be expected to be in relationship with the parents as they think of how to engage the individual students in discipleship

Fellowship:

- Be present at all youth activities possible, be active participants in youth activities, and reach out to students present.

Training:

- Interns will be challenged to further their knowledge of who they are, and how their gifts might best fit into kingdom work.
- Interns will receive coaching on ministry including discipleship and teaching. - Interns will meet weekly with youth pastor to go through, and discuss in depth, selected books.

Compensation:

- Interns will be paid the 1st and 15th of each month. The stipend is \$4000 for the summer.

- Ministry expenses (mileage and student contact) will be covered as needed month.
- Events and trips will be covered for the interns.
- Any required reading will be purchased for the interns.
- HHPC will help place interns who need summer housing with a host family.

Work hours: June – August 4th, 2018

- Generally 6 days, 40+ hours a week. An example week might be budgeted like: Sunday School: 2 hours, Small Groups: 2 hours, Wednesday Night: 3 hours, Weekly Events: 5 hours, Contact: 12 hours, Training/Meetings: 6 hours, Preparation/Study: 3 hours, Administration: 7 hours.
- Interns will be used as needed on Jr. High and Sr. High trips. We will make every effort to get interns on at least one summer trip.
 - Time off:
 - Interns will be required to take one assigned day off per week as a day of rest.
 - Interns will get 3 vacation days during internship (staff approval is required).
 - Time missed because of illness, family tragedy, or severe weather will be excused.
