Position: Director of Children's Ministry

In light of this mission, the purpose of this position is to oversee the various ministry programs that serve the children of Crossroads from Nursery through 6th grade which are intended to come alongside their parents in faithfully teaching and modeling for them the gospel of Jesus Christ.

Qualifications:

- A personal, growing, and maturing faith in Jesus Christ
- A member in good standing at Crossroads (NOTE: not required to apply)
- A love for the Bible and a desire to teach it to children
- An understanding of and agreement with the Reformed faith
- A love for children and an ability and passion to teach, shepherd, lead, engage, and enjoy them in a winsome, gospel-centered manner
- An ability and desire to partner with parents in ministering to their children
- An ability to organize and lead a multi-faceted ministry
- An ability to recruit, equip, and delegate leaders
- Strong written and verbal communication skills
- An ability to tailor curriculum to meet age appropriate needs

Primary Responsibilities:

- Continue developing the ministry in line with CCC's mission, vision, and core values
- Oversee weekly worship hour and Sunday School programs
- Oversee monthly game nights (3rd/4th & 5th/6th) and Bible studies (5th/6th)
- Oversee annual Vacation Bible School (1 week outreach event in June)
- Oversee annual Communicants Class (8 week Sunday evening course Aug – Oct)
- Oversee other special church-related or outreach events involving children
- Recruit, equip, delegate, and support volunteer leaders for the various Children's Ministry programs and events
- Provide leadership and support to the Part-time Nursery Coordinator and volunteer leader of the Dean LeCompte Library
- Select/Organize/Create doctrinally sound curriculum and periodically review for effectiveness and ease of use
- Love and serve the parents through effective communication, resources, and care for their children.
- Prepare and manage the annual Children's Ministry budget
- Attend annual training and engage with resources that spur continual growth in ministry

Commitment & Compensation:

- Part-time position averaging 25hrs/week. Compensation to be discussed during the interview process.
