PURPOSE OF POSITION

To glorify God by leading the congregation through Gospel-centered worship.

MINISTRY SUMMARY

The Worship Director is responsible to lead the congregation in worship. The Worship Director is responsible for training and shepherding worship team members and overseeing the worship portion of services. Additionally, this position is responsible for the overall production of all worship services of the church. The Worship Director reports to, works with and is accountable to the Senior Pastor.

QUALIFICATIONS

1. Love for Jesus and a desire to see lives and communities changed by the gospel.

2. Excellent vocal and musical ability.
3. A strong leader who also has the ability to develop/coach others.
4. A learner, someone who is always looking for new ideas and strategies to improve our worship ministry.
5. An appreciation for and ability to provide a variety of traditions and styles of music, including hymns and contemporary worship songs, representing a diversity of styles, all done with excellence.
6. Ability to organize, plan, communicate, develop teams, delegate and empower others on the mission.
7. Ability to work with and maintain positive relationships with those inside and outside the church.
8. Mature ability to handle sensitive issues and maintain confidentiality.
9. Experience and strong knowledge of the technical side of audio/visual elements of worship.
10. Ability to plan occasional special music, such as adult choir or kids music.

DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Worship Services:

1. In corroboration with the Senior Pastor, select songs and arrangements for worship services that convey the gospel message.
2. Promote a diverse, inter-generational worship atmosphere through music selection, a unique mix of hymns (& styles) and current worship songs.
3. Oversee all areas of production; including audio, lighting, presentation slides, service management, equipment maintenance and online presentation.

Worships Teams:

1. Empower and encourage instrumentalists, vocalists and production team members.
2. Provide the music and song sheets each week.

3. Shepherd staff and volunteers serving with bands and production teams.
4. Coordinate song lyrics with the production team.

Additional duties and responsibilities

1. Attend regular staff meetings.
2. Lead worship for special services.
3. Will lead and/or oversee a choir on rare occasion.
4. Willingness to coach youth worship teams.

COMPENSATION

Christ Church Greensboro Worship Vision & Core Values

God is worthy of our worship, Christ is central to our worship, and the Spirit empowers our worship

“Let everything that has breath praise the LORD!” (Psalm 150:6)

Worship is:

- Our proper response to God
- Directed by God – we worship Him as He commands, not as we prefer
- Individual (daily) and corporate (when we gather on Sunday and on other occasions)
- The heart of all we do – our daily living and service is done as unto Christ, for His glory and to His praise – Sunday is a preparation for/culmination of our daily lives of worship
- Not encompassed by one tradition, style, or era
- Engagement of all we are – body (physical), heart (emotions), mind (intellectual) and soul (spiritual)
- Accessible to all God’s church irrespective of age, ethnicity, (dis)ability, education/intellect, economic standing
- Power for God’s people to engage in His mission for His world

CCG’s gathered (Sunday) worship should be:

- Focused on the majesty, might and mercy of our Father as He is revealed in Christ
- Affirming of who we are as His people
 - Image bearers – those made in the image of God, with dignity and purpose
 - Recovered enemies – sinful rebels, redeemed and restored by God’s mercy
 - Beloved children – a family of broken people, restored to wholeness with God, one another, and God’s world by the power of Christ’s death and resurrection
 - A royal priesthood – holy and set apart for His purposes
 - People of purpose – ambassadors called to the advance of God’s kingdom
- Empowering for God’s purposes – the music, prayers, confessions, preaching, testimonies, etc. should all reflect (and inspire) the passion and energy flowing from God’s redemption and renewal of His people
- Excellent – God is worthy of our best in all things
- Passionate and energized – God is worthy of our engaged, whole-hearted worship
- Engaging of all we are (and hope to be)
 - Must reflect the diversity we seek as a core value – no one style or persuasion dominates, but there is a core that reflects our identity as a particular people called to worship in a particular place and time
 - Must be about more than music – Scripture, responsive readings, corporate confession, prayer, quiet reflection – all play a role in our worship
 - Must engage us body, heart, mind and soul – visual imagery, physical movement, awed silence, animated/joyful proclamation, depth in the spoken and proclaimed word – all play a part in giving our best in response to God’s worth as we respond to the leading of His Spirit
 - Must be a faithful conduit of the Gospel as the power of God for His people
- A reflection of who we (CCG now and in the future) are
 - We value authenticity and vulnerability – that should be evident throughout our gathered times of worship
 - Our vision, mission and core values should be evident in and affirmed through our gathered times of worship
 - A first time visitor will know who we are and what we value from our worship
