

# Children's Ministry Coordinator

## Overview

The children's ministry director at Restoration PCA will work under the oversight of the Session to design and build the Restoration Kids Ministry (RKM). The primary role of the director is to provide vision and direction for the leaders and volunteers to ensure that we provide a safe and loving environment for our children to learn God's story, grow in Christ-centered faith, and become full, active participants in the family of God.

## Position Qualifications

- Find identity, meaning and purpose in the person and work (life, death, and resurrection) of Jesus
- Willingness to participate in the life of Restoration PCA as a covenant member, fully participating in a life consistent with our identity and mission
- Dedicated to Restoration's vision and excited to develop Kids Ministry in a context of church revitalization
- Strong relational skills, able to work well with people
- Dependable, responsible, self-motivated and creative
- Gifted in administration with the ability to coordinate a team
- Committed to a team model of ministry rooted in an environment of grace
- Passionate about ministry to children and seeing both parents and children grow in faith
- Willing and able to work with children across the spectrum of needs (experience working with special needs children a plus)

## Position Responsibilities

Sunday (2-3 hours)

- Oversee the execution of the RKM, including leadership team and volunteers
- Be the face of RKM to the congregation, providing updates and casting vision

Weekly (approximately 5-6 hours)

- Lead and develop the Restoration Kids leadership team and volunteers
- Maintain communications with the congregation
- Attend bi-monthly staff meeting

Responsibilities may be subject to some change as deemed necessary by the Session.
