4	Whereas, an important aspect of any case of process is the gathering and presenting of
5	evidence, including testimony produced by witnesses;

7	Whereas, testimony by witnesses before the court can be inconvenient due to geographic
8	distance or other circumstances;

10	Whereas, it is important that witnesses be examined with an opportunity to be cross-examined
11	by both parties (<i>cf. BCO</i> 32-13); and

13	Whereas, technology has made available the possibility of having a virtual presence with
14	video and audio interaction even when a person is geographically distant from a
15	meeting or court room, and the courts of the civil magistrate allow for video testimony
16 17	by witnesses;
17	Therefore, be it resolved, that the General Assembly of the Presbyterian Church in America
18 19	amend <i>BCO</i> 32-8 with the following (additions are underlined, deletions are struck

21	32-8 . When the offense with which an accused person stands charged took
22	place at a distance, and <u>or</u> it is inconvenient for the witnesses to appear before
23 24	the court having jurisdiction, that court may either (a) appoint a commission of
25	its body, or (b) request the coordinate court contiguous to the place where the
26	facts occurred, to take the testimony for it, or (c) have the testimony taken by
27	videoconference, which shall employ technical means that ensure that all
28	persons participating in the meeting can see and hear each other at the same
29	time, and which allows for live cross-examination by both parties. The accused
30	shall always have reasonable notice of the time and place of the meeting of this
31	commission or coordinate court.
