22	WE AFFIRM that God has designed marriage to be a covenantal, sexual,
23	procreative, lifelong union of one man and one woman, as husband and wife,
24	and is meant to signify the covenant love between Christ and his bride the

26	WE DENY that God has designed marriage to be a homosexual, polygamous,
27	or polyamorous relationship. We also deny that marriage is a mere human

In addition to affirming these historic, orthodox truths, the Nashville Statement also lifts up the hope of the gospel to the sexual struggler, pointing the reader to our Lord Jesus Christ as "the double cure," saving us both from sin's guilt and power.
