- Contact Work (50%)
 - Spend time with middle and high students, building relationships with them and their families.
 - Lead a JH and SH journey group
 - Assist leadership at Heart2Heart/FistBump (5th/6th Grade Ministry)
 - Disciple students through a contact group of JH and SH students
- Program Responsibilities (25%)
 - Assist in planning, organizing, and implementing Wednesday and Sunday programs
 - Responsible for planning and leading games for Wednesday and Sunday programs
 - Assist with set up, implementing, and clean up for special events and activities
- Teaching (10%)
 - Teach at Wednesday and Sunday evening programs, and Sunday School
 - Assist staff in curriculum selection and development
- Personal Development (5%)
 - Meet with youth staff one on one and in weekly staff meetings
 - Read assigned books pertaining to theological, personal, and ministry development
- Trips (5%)
 - Assist in planning, leading, and implementing JH and SH trips throughout the year
