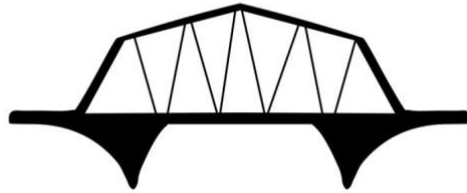

Job Overview

The ideal candidate for this position will be prepared to provide general support for the daily operations of the church, both organizational and ministerial. The candidate would be newer to pastoral church ministry and desire the opportunity to learn, be trained, and grow in their love for Jesus and His Church. The candidate must have an M.Div. (or if currently completing it, graduating in spring 2020).

Responsibilities and Duties

- Youth and Family Ministry
 - Assist setting the vision and ministerial philosophy for the youth ministry.
 - Oversee and execute two youth meetings monthly during the school year, and weekly meetings during summer.
 - Oversee one or more Reformed Youth Movement (RYM) trip and/or mission trip per year.
 - Meet with youth and parents individually as able or as needed.
 - Help lead parent-team that oversees youth ministry.
 - We are not looking for a programmatic ministry machine. We would like someone to walk alongside parents and give shape to our youth ministry.

- Worship
 - Work with Senior Pastor and worship leaders in overseeing Liturgy.
 - Assist leading in worship regularly.
 - Assist leading music in a support capacity, if capable (not required).
 - Along with Senior Pastor be first point of contact with visitors by following up on first-time visitor information cards collected.

- Aid administrative assistant with scheduling membership meetings with those interested in joining the church.
- Work with musicians to oversee Christmas program and special services.
- General
 - Assist senior pastor with small groups as needed. This may involve helping to set vision and purpose, as well as structuring and planning.
 - Preach every 4-6 weeks.
 - Assist in community outreach.
 - Teach adult or youth Sunday school when needed and able.

Qualifications:

Candidate will be expected to have character in line with the Gospel (Galatians 2), fleshed out in the descriptions in 1 Timothy. Candidate must have an M.Div from a credible seminary. Candidate must be gospel-centered in his approach to himself, his family and ministry, and Presbyterian in his convictions as summarized in the Westminster Confession of Faith and catechisms.

Hours: 50 hours a week (flexible schedule with some regular office hours).

Salary: Competitive and commensurate with skill level and experience.

Benefits: Health insurance will either be provided or compensated. Retirement will be provided.

Vacation: 3 weeks a year with one week of study leave.
