Young Meadows Presbyterian Church Position Description Youth and College Director/Pastor

The Youth and College Director (full-time) is responsible for outreach and ministry to youth and college students. The Y/CD will nurture community among existing youth and college students, while seeking to be on local high school and college campuses to engage other unreached students. Candidates should embrace and embody the mission of Young Meadows. An ideal candidate is a recent college graduate, who was active in campus ministry, and who is discerning his calling to ministry in the church. (Ordained position is also a possibility for candidates who are enrolled or have completed seminary) Responsibilities include:

- Create and manage a youth and college ministry calendar that will drive all activities and teaching within the church, including discipleship, fellowship activities, and outreach.
- Oversee large group, small group, and one-on-one discipleship for youth and college students.
- Nurture a community of belonging for youth and college students. Invite youth and college students into homes regularly for fellowship events, pursue students at schools, and attend extracurricular activities.
- College specifically: Target local A.U.M. (Auburn University-Montgomery) campus to establish ministry to college students.
- Encourage the integration of youth and college students into other ministries of the church.
- Oversee quarterly Youth Leadership Ministry Team to help ensure the vision of the youth ministry is being protected.
- Ensure communication with youth, college, parents, volunteers, and the entire church regarding youth and college ministry activities.
- Prepare for and participate in weekly staff meeting.
- Prepare weekly time accounting for Supervising Pastor.
- Optional: Develop, plan, communicate, and participate in Youth Seasonal Retreat with other PCA Churches.

MINISTRY HEART & ATTITUDE: Candidates must do these tasks with a God given desire and passion. Their character needs to be above reproach and their life needs to be an example of grace-given godliness. They must be able to connect with youth and college students with godly compassion. In addition to being excited about such a ministry, they need to be teachable, humble, and faithful.
