To develop and lead the worship music ministry for our church, in consultation with the pastors and other team members, in a way that is consistent with our mission, values, and theology.

Responsibilities:

- Select and plan music for Sunday services.
- Participate in the creative planning of the Sunday and special services with the Pastors
- Research, review, and recommend new music for services that fits our Reformed theological convictions.
- Recruit, equip, motivate, and supervise music team leaders, musicians and technical A/V team.
- Develop musical teams and ensembles for services.
- Maintain a strong prayer base for the music ministry.
- Participate in weekly worship service review and planning session.
- Participate in the life and ministry of the church.

- Authentic relationship with Jesus Christ as Savior and Lord.
- Ability to recruit and coach volunteer musicians and encourage them in their Christian life.
