

**Job Description:**

This is a part-time staff position averaging 20 to 30 hours per week to serve the youth and children ministry (depending on Seminary workload). It would be desired that this position begins in the Fall 2021. The Director of Youth Ministries will be a part of the leadership team of First Presbyterian Church of Tuscumbia. As such he will be required to grow in his understanding of God and His Word. He will seek to mature in all areas of his life, but especially his spiritual life. He will be required to be faithful in his attendance and involvement in the total ministry of the church. His ministry responsibilities are as follows:

**Children's Program (K4-6<sup>th</sup> Grade)**

- Coordinate Sunday school and Wednesday evening curriculum and volunteers
- Oversee and select curriculum for the Children's Summer Coordinator (hired for the summer) or any other youth staff or interns. The Children's Summer Coordinator is normally hired to run a daytime weekly program for the K4-6<sup>th</sup> graders, teach this group on Wednesday nights during the summer, and send out a calendar to parents detailing the summer children events
- Recruit volunteers, organize, plan, and direct VBS in the summer
- Plan occasional events with 5<sup>th</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> graders
- Oversee volunteers for any organized children's events during the year

**Youth Program (7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> Grade)**

- Coordinate Sunday school curriculum and volunteers
- Select and teach curriculum on Wednesday evenings
- Plan and organize "Senior Sunday" activities every May
- Plan fellowship activities, such as those after Sunday evening service
- Organize and administrate youth events and activities
- Organize youth service projects

- Plan, attend and recruit volunteers for summer RYM beach trip with Senior High
- Plan, direct, and recruit volunteers for a fall retreat with the youth group
- Maintain a presence at every school represented by FPC youth group
- Develop contacts with schools for further ministry
- Keep track of youth budget and expenditures
- Encourage youth attendance and involvement in church

**Position Qualifications:**

- We are looking for someone that is willing to relocate in order to serve our church while they finish up seminary.
- A committed and humble Christian, actively following Jesus by faith alone, through grace alone.
- A commitment to the Reformed Presbyterian faith as put forward in the Westminster Standards.
- 2-3 years of youth leadership ministry experience.
- Experience in communication, teaching, and event management.
- Able to work flexible hours on weekends and weekday evenings.
- A completed Bachelor's Degree.
- A seminary student, or a willingness to take seminary classes.
- Willingness to become a member OR associate member of our church.
- Willingness to undergo a background check and a child protection training seminar.
