Primary Responsibilities: These responsibilities will occupy the majority of the pastor's time

- Cultivates Evangelism and Outreach Initiatives within Trinity Community
- Plans, Oversees and Conducts Community Outreach Events and Ministries
- Cultivates Contacts within the Local Community
- Oversees Website and Social Media Ministries
- Liaison for World Missions Committee

General Pastoral Responsibilities: These responsibilities occur regularly

- Regular preacher (Frequency TBD)
- Rotational worship planning and liturgical leadership
- Regular teaching (SS, Men's Bible Study, Women's Bible Study, Connect, Officer Training)
- General Pastoral Care and Visitation
- Counseling (As Needed)
- Session meetings; Presbytery and General Assembly (rotationally)
- Use of musical gifts (if applicable)

Reporting Relationships: The Assistant Pastor of Outreach reports directly to the Lead Pastor and works with a team of ruling elders who assist in overseeing the outreach ministries of the church. Ultimately, the Assistant Pastor of Outreach is accountable to the Session.
