- Oversee and assure maintenance and care of all equipment for this area of ministry as well as evaluate and suggest equipment needs for this area of ministry.
- Recruit and schedule music team volunteers, prepare liturgy, music, and music team for weekly worship gatherings as well as special services within the liturgical year and HHPC's life and ministry.
- Lead "all-HHPC" worship gatherings such as Holy Week services, hymn sings, etc.
- Participate in and further HHPC's mission, values, and core beliefs in order to equip God's people to use God's gifts for God's glory.
- Provide contents for the bulletin and oversee a visual presentation in conjunction with the Sunday worship service in a prompt fashion.
- Perform other duties assigned by leadership.
