

Christ the King Church (PCA) in Wilmington, NC invites applications for senior pastor. CtK is a church of approximately 125 members who esteem the Bible as the Word of God and value the Westminster Confession as an excellent summary of biblical doctrine. Our Sunday worship service features the reading of the Word, preaching, prayer, and praise. Our ministries include mercy ministry, women's ministry, and RUF (at the University of North Carolina Wilmington, a university of almost 18,000 students).

Our church: The church worships in our own church building which includes the sanctuary, fellowship hall and kitchen, extensive classroom spaces for adults and children of all ages, and the senior pastor's office. Our vision and mission statements reflect who we are as a church body, and our ministerial profile provides an excellent overview of the giftedness desired of the pastor who will best fit this position:

Vision: To glorify God and love the people of Wilmington and the world by sharing the gospel of Jesus Christ and by supporting works of ministry in His name.

Mission: Christ the King Church proclaims the Word of God for the salvation and discipleship of God's people, worships together in spiritual union, provides for our members and our community, and prepares believers for evangelism and works of ministry.

Our community: Wilmington is a community nestled between the Atlantic Ocean and the Cape Fear River and is an attractive location for families, singles, and retirees who enjoy great weather and outdoor recreational activities including golf, swimming, surfing, fishing and boating. The community is a host to two institutions of higher education (Cape Fear Community College and the University of North Carolina Wilmington) and many small, medium, and large businesses. The area is growing rapidly as people seek to live in a location that is vibrant but still has a small-town feel. Our church building is located in a residential neighborhood situated not far from the heart of downtown - an ideal location to minister to our city.

Application Process: The confidential application process is open immediately and will remain open until the position is filled. Priority consideration will be given to candidates who apply by August 7, 2021. The start date is no later than June 1, 2022. To apply, candidates should submit the following:

- A cover letter stating an interest in the position.
- An updated resume.
- An updated ministerial data sheet.
- The means for the search committee to listen to three sermons preached by the candidate.

When we receive notice of your application, we will send an email advising that the application is either complete or incomplete.

Search Committee Timeline: The search committee will review applications as they are received. Candidates who are prayerfully considered as a possible "fit" for CtK will be further contacted for written responses to a set of search committee questions. Once the questions are completed, candidates who advance in the search deliberations will be contacted for an interview.
