- Applicable education or experience in Youth Ministry or youth programs (recommended: Bachelor's degree in Youth Ministry or similar field and 2+ years youth ministry experience)

Specific Responsibilities:

- Oversee and help lead weekly ministry groups of senior high and mid-high students.
- Plan and lead retreats, mission projects, and outreach events to the community and schools.
- Partner with parents to help students to grow as disciples of Jesus at home.
- Oversee and help lead Sunday School classes for mid-high and senior high youth.
- Recruit and equip adult volunteer youth leaders.
- Work to integrate youth into the life and leadership of the church (e.g. worship, children's ministries, community outreach, world outreach, etc.)
- Work with Elders to lead committee meetings and oversee budgets
- Other responsibilities designated by the Pastor.
