Position Summary

They must have experience with creating systems for sustainable ministry and executing ongoing and new plans in order to faithfully minister to the over 60 children at Grace!

Responsibilities

- Love and connect with children and their families at church and in the community.
- Plan out and execute plans for the 2 different Covenant Kids classes (Pre-K/4-Kindergarten, -1st-2nd grade) and as well the preschool nursery class.
- Choose curriculum and plan usage throughout the children's ministry.
- Help lead and plan Deluxe meetings (Grace's ministry to 3rd-5th graders).
- Train, equip, and implement Backyard Bible Clubs.
- Help plan and implement children's Christian Education classes.
- Coordinate with the Nursery Coordinator with regards to volunteer scheduling.
- Attend monthly staff meetings.
- Attend and assist with volunteer leader encouragement and training.
- Pursue further equipping through conferences and a personal development plan.

- A follower of Christ who is seeking to mature in their faith.
- A heart to see children grow in their knowledge and love of God.
- Has experience with teaching and connecting with children in a variety of contexts.
- Efficient and skilled communicator with parents, families, and the wider congregation.

- Consistent availability to attend different ministry events (Backyard Bible Clubs, Deluxe, etc.).
