Position Description

Assistant Pastor

Overview: The Assistant Pastor will spend about 60% of his time investing in 7th-12th grade students and their families within our church and community. The remainder of his time, he can serve in other ministry areas that best fit his gifting (i.e. – administration, counseling, etc.) He will serve at the direction of the Session and will report directly to the Pastor. Preferable candidates will have completed seminary and are ready to be ordained.

Responsibilities include:

- Youth Ministry
 - Build relationships with students and their families for the purpose of life-on-life discipleship.
 - Recruit and work with volunteers to help disciple the youth in our church.
 - Develop student leaders who can in turn help disciple younger students.
 - Teach during the weekly youth meeting
 - Plan and carry out youth activities throughout the year (i.e., pool parties, movie trips, game nights, retreats, etc.)
 - Maintain and stay within ministry budget

- General Ministry
 - Reach out and develop relationships within our broader community
 - Attend weekly staff meetings
 - Meet with the Pastor once a week for mentoring and accountability
 - Aid Pastor in planning and leading Sunday Worship
 - Preach approximately 8-12 times yearly
 - Attend Elders and Deacons meetings
 - Attend Presbytery & General Assembly and be involved in meetings and committee assignments.

- Personal Development
 - Take one day of prayer a month
 - Attend training conferences or retreats
