Pastoral Intern

Overview: The Pastoral Apprenticeship is designed to test, train and develop a man on the path to full-time vocational ministry. It comes before and during formal seminary training to serve as a practical “lab” to help the apprentice integrate his studies with real life in ministry. The Pastoral Intern serves at the direction of the Session and reports to the Pastor.

Responsibilities include:

- Youth Ministry
 - Build relationships with students and their families for the purpose of life-on-life discipleship.
 - Recruit and work with volunteers to help disciple the youth in our church.
 - Develop student leaders who can in turn help disciple younger students.
 - Teach during the weekly youth meeting
 - Plan and carry out youth activities throughout the year (i.e. pool parties, movie trips, game nights, retreats, etc.)
 - Maintain and stay within ministry budget

- General Ministry
 - Reach out and develop relationships within our broader community
 - Attend weekly staff meetings
 - Meet with the Pastor once a week for mentoring and accountability
 - Aid Pastor in planning and leading Sunday Worship
 - Work towards preaching 8-10 times a year
 - Attend Elders and Deacons meetings as needed

- Personal Development
 - Take one day of prayer a month
 - Begin working through seminary
 - Attend training conferences or retreats
