Who We Are

Assistant Pastor of Youth & Families

Safe Harbor Presbyterian Church is looking to hire a pastor who will lead our student ministries and assist our families in making true disciples of Christ. The position will be dedicated 50% to this integral youth and family work, while the other 50% will be comprised of other assistant pastor duties, including preaching, leading Sunday School, and implementing the vision of the church. The candidate must reflect a strong personal integrity as well as modeling a heart of service. He must have a strong desire for evangelism and discipleship as well as an unflinching commitment to the Word of God as an anchor for all of life.

The candidate must be ordained or prepared to be ordained in the PCA. He would report to the Senior Pastor and assist with leading worship, attend staff meetings and regularly meet with the Senior Pastor for discipleship and prayer.

Job Requirements Are as Follows:

- An MDiv or equivalent degree
- Experience in the area of student or children's ministry preferred
- Commitment to the doctrinal standards of the PCA
- Strong relational capacity with both students and parents
- Strong teacher of God's Word
- Willingness to grow and be shepherded under the care of the Senior Pastor
- Willingness to assist with other elements of church discipleship as needed: i.e., small groups, Christian education
- A vision-caster: someone who can share a vision for family ministry at our church

Primary Responsibilities:

- Oversee Safe Harbor Youth activities including large group meetings for middle school and high school
- Initiate and lead Bible studies for youth in both middle school and high school
- Oversee Sunday School curriculum and planning for children of all ages
- Oversee Christian education for youth and families including our nurseries, children's worship
- Regularly visit, encourage, and pray with young families of Safe Harbor
- Develop a team of volunteers within the church to assist with all youth functions

Other Responsibilities:

- Active participation and leadership in Christian education and small groups
- Encourage the participation of youth in all areas of church life: worship, missions, service, etc.
- Lead worship in rotation with the Senior Pastor and elders of the church
- Preaching every 6-8 weeks
- Regularly update the Session on activities and challenges within ministry to youth and families
- Manages the background check process in coordination with our administrative leadership

Hours and Compensation:

- This position is a full-time, salaried position
- Compensation commensurate with experience
- Benefits include health care and 3 weeks vacation
