Being a Summer Intern is a 12 week, full time commitment. Please note that an additional job during your internship or taking summer college courses will not be possible. Hiring decisions are based upon a completed application (including two references). We reserve the right to terminate your position at any time for any unbiblical conduct, safety concerns, and/or leadership detrimental to the body of Christ.
