Job Description

Lakeside Presbyterian Church, a congregation of the PCA in Southlake, TX, is seeking candidates for a full-time Assistant Pastor. The successful candidate will assist the Sr. Pastor in all general pastoral activities, primarily in the development and implementation of Youth and Family activities serving the congregation of Lakeside and the surrounding community. Lakeside PCA is a thriving and growing church committed to the ordinary means of grace and the principles of the Reformation as established in scripture and the Westminster standards.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1) General Pastoral Responsibilities
 - Pray for the people of Lakeside
 - Teach in the various education ministries of Lakeside
 - Participate in the shepherding and visitation ministries of Lakeside
 - Assist in worship and liturgy planning
 - Work with staff assistant to issue pastoral communications, prayer requests, social media, and other announcements
 - Occasionally preach and administer the sacraments (EST time/year)
 - Attend Session and participate in North Texas Presbytery meetings
 - Assist with other pastoral activities as assigned by the Lead Pastor
- 2) Specific Youth and Family Responsibilities
 - Organize and teach weekly Youth discipleship activities
 - Recruit adult volunteers for Youth-related activities
 - Develop relationships with Lakeside Youth and organize spiritual mentorship activities between youth and adults
 - Recruit, organize, and equip teachers for Youth Sunday School
 - Take charge of Lakeside's Community Group ministry:
 - Develop a theme of "Covenant Living" with an emphasis on the Reformed understanding of what it means for the local church to be one body united in Christ
 - Recruit and equip Community Group leaders
 - Work with session and group leaders to help craft discipleship and fellowship activities
 - Generate interest and participation by engaging and exhorting congregation
 - Organize and provide leadership to Children's Ministry
 - Oversee all aspects of Children's Ministry, coordinating with Children's Ministry directors
 - Recruit and train adult volunteers for Children's Ministry activities
 - Recruit, organize, and equip teachers for Children's Sunday School

REQUIREMENTS

1. Maintain an exemplary Christian testimony in humble dependence on the grace of the Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God the Father, and the fellowship of the Holy Spirit.
2. Meet the biblical requirements for elders in 1 Tim. 3:1-7, Titus 1:5-9, and 1 Pet. 5:1-4.
3. Meet the denominational requirements to be ordained a Teaching Elder in the PCA.
4. Enthusiastically embrace Lakeside's ordinary means of grace ministry and be wholeheartedly committed to its execution under Lakeside's leadership.
