Proclamation of the Word

King's Church seeks to have the Gospel heard each week through expository preaching that challenges and exhorts Christ followers and Christ seekers to be transformed and renewed in their walk.

Spiritual Formation and Discipleship

King's Church makes new and maturing disciples of Jesus. All of our ministries define success by this question: "Are people becoming more like Christ?" We believe discipleship happens most effectively in large and small groups where young and old develop strong spiritual bonds. Within this family environment, disciples engage with the Word of God, speak the Gospel to one another and learn to abide with Jesus on a daily basis. These relationships are life transforming and unleash our people to boldly take risks, sharing God's love in tangible ways with our neighbors.

Evangelism and Outreach

King's Church builds missional partnerships with other like-minded individuals, churches and organizations that are committed to the advancement of God's kingdom in Long Beach and around the world. We gravitate towards opportunities to serve the most vulnerable and hurting in our communities. We also believe new church plants are an effective way to reach people with the Gospel of Jesus.

Worship Leadership

At King's Church, the service is designed for active participation in every aspect of the worship service: from printed quotes on the cover of the Sunday bulletin or on the screen designed for personal meditation and reflection, to the call to worship, the responsive reading of Scripture, the time of confession, and the singing of traditional and contemporary songs; all these elements are planned to complement the preaching of God's Word and to experience the life-changing power of the Gospel each week.

Diaconal Ministries

King's Church seeks to have a ministry where our members can be honest with the deacons and elders about prayer concerns, their marriages, friendships and relationships, and financial and relational issues. Knowing and being responsive to the physical and spiritual needs of people within our church but also in our community is a value we hold high.

Congregational Fellowship

King's Church places a high priority on getting to know one another and building each other up. Each member is encouraged on a regular basis to be plugged in to a community group; there are also triad groups for more intimate groups of three to meet for friendship and spiritual growth and discipleship. Organized Lunches after church are planned throughout the year, and opportunities to gather at individual homes are encouraged. King's Church fosters a culture where people are encouraged to linger after services to talk with each other or grab lunch at a local restaurant in small and large groups. Retreats and special events have been well attended.
