- **The candidate must have served no less than 20 years as a Senior Pastor, preferably with over ten years in one church and over five years in a church of more than 250 members.**

### **Prophet (Loves to Preach the Word; Prayer; Expository)**

1. Theologically sound expository preaching of the Word of God and strong biblical teaching that is engaging and relatable to the congregation and encourages application.
2. Devoted to the service of Christ and the church.
3. Glorifies and honors God in worship.
4. Administer the sacraments and faithfully give oneself to pastoral work.
5. Lead prayer meetings that lift up petitions of the church body.

### **King (Brings Visionary, Entrepreneurial, Collaborative Leadership; Dominion, Peace)**

1. Help navigate the transition from our legacy Senior Pastor to a new Senior Pastor.
2. Mentor and evaluate pastoral staff and church staff.
3. Equip and mentor present and future members of the session and diaconate.
4. Teach and equip the congregation and lay leadership to do the work of ministry fostering strong organization and collaboration within the ministries.
5. Educate members and regular attenders on the doctrine of the Presbyterian Church of America and the Book of Church Order.
6. Provide clear communication between staff, officers, and the congregation.
7. Model servant leadership.
8. Serve as an ex-officio member of the Diaconate and all church committees, *as he deems necessary or helpful*.
9. Serve as the staff lead and point of contact for all church ministries and moderate all Session meetings.
10. Lead the church officers and staff in vision discernment and in short- and long-range planning.

**Priest (Shepherd, Righteousness; Loves to Deliver Tactile Pastoral Care)**

1. Provide spiritual and pastoral leadership and care to Carriage Lane Presbyterian Church.
2. Promote unity within the congregation and facilitate restoration of any unresolved offenses.
3. Develop the spiritual gifts and talents of the church officers and staff to facilitate their service to the church body.
