

Job Description for Church Planter in Fussa, Japan

Ministry to the Military & Internationals (MM&I), a ministry of Southeast Alabama Presbytery, (PCA), has designated Yokota Air Force Base a strategic location. MM&I plans to plant a Presbyterian and Reformed Church in that location. Yokota is home to Headquarters, U.S. Forces Japan and Fifth Air Force. There are approximately 14,000 military personnel assigned to the base and a significant number of Japanese civilian employees. Fussa City has approximately 60,000 residents. The base is 28 miles northwest of Tokyo at the foot of the Okutama Mountains. It is 73 kilometers from Yokosuka U.S. Naval Base. The MM&I Commission believes our Airmen and Sailors, along with family members, are deserving of and will benefit greatly by an ordinary means of grace ministry while serving their nation abroad. Additionally, we want a minister who will reach out to the Japanese population and any others that God may bring into his sphere of influence. We are searching for a candidate who is fully committed to and who will hold tenaciously to our Standards which are the inerrant and infallible Word of God, the biblical administration of the the Sacraments, and a man whose prayers are deeply rooted in the Word of God. He should also have a good working knowledge of the PCA BCO. We are looking for a man with the courage to move to a foreign country and carry out the Great Commission. Could that be you?

Our service men and women are some of the best America has to offer. They serve with distinction and some will die in defense of our nation and in defense of other nations as well.
