PART TIME MUSIC DIRECTOR**

Cornerstone's Music Director will be responsible for leading musically inspiring worship services and for development of worship ministry. He or she will serve part-time (12-15 hours per week). Compensation is commensurate with experience.

Position Qualifications:

- Demonstrated experience leading worship teams and worship services that are musically inspiring, Scripture-filled, gospel-centered, mission-focused, engaging, and joyful.
- A committed follower of Jesus Christ who demonstrates spiritual maturity and a growing personal relationship with Jesus Christ.
- Strong musical, interpersonal, and administrative skills.
- A desire to learn and collaborate with pastors and ministry staff.

Job description:

Weekly worship planning and execution

- Plan service liturgy in conjunction with Pastoral staff.
- Confirm song selection blending the sermon theme with intentional hymnody (see worship white paper). Implement a strategy for integrating new songs to prevent sets from getting too repetitive.
- Lead the worship team in preparation (rehearsal) for Sunday worship and lead the congregation in musical worship on Sunday mornings.
- Lead volunteer audio/visual team to have the liturgy ready to project on Sunday morning utilizing Planning Center and ProPresenter or other tools.
- Continue to develop the live-stream ministry; oversee, train, and build teams to run the live-streaming services.

Ministry development

- Recruit, train and lead the music team, including scheduled music team meetings (quarterly) and opportunities for music lessons (twice per year). Intentionally seek new or underutilized talent in the congregation or other paid musicians to supplement the team as needed.
- Recruit, train and lead the audio/visual team.
- Oversee equipment/technology maintenance or additions aligned with the established worship budget.
- Incorporate special music working with staff/ministry teams. Examples include occasional use of a choir, children's choir, youth group participation in worship music, guest musician, etc.
- Continue to develop a culture of excellence in all areas of worship, including musicianship, musically inspiring gospel liturgy, audio/visual execution, etc.
- May be asked to report periodically to the session on ministry goals and progress.

Understand Cornerstone's value of being *Devoted to Worship*

- Understanding of and agreement with Cornerstone's ministry plan
- Implementation of gospel liturgy and Reformed elements in weekly worship

Position reports to the Senior Pastor with oversight by Cornerstone's Session. Worship practices are guided by the worship white paper in Cornerstone's ministry plan.
